The Salter/Saulter Family Memorial Scholarship Application Process

The Background

The Salter/Saulter Family Memorial Scholarship began as the Mary Ruth Farmer Scholarship Fund. This fund was established in honor of Mary Ruth's long standing dedication and her contributions to the Salter/Saulter family. In an effort to afford the opportunity for other family members to memorialize respective loved ones and become all-encompassing, the family voted to change the name to the above mentioned.

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for expressing interest in a Salter/Saulter Family Memorial Scholarship.

The Salter/Saulter Family personifies commitment, integrity and kindness and exemplifies community involvement, interest in continuous education and development of leadership skills. These scholarships are intended to supplement deserving graduating high school seniors as they begin their first year of post graduate education. We pray that these scholarships, albeit small, may be the catalyst to encourage you as you further your education. This family will continue praying for you as you strive to become a productive contributor to your community and family.

An applicant for the Salter/Saulter Family Memorial Scholarship must:

- Be a high school senior
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.50 after the first semester of the senior year
- Plan to attend a four-year college or university, or other post graduate educational institutions in the fall of their graduating year.

A complete application should include ALL of the following:

- Completed application form.
- Typewritten essay addressing the following question:
 - What does family mean to you and your plan to give back
 - Must have a minimum of 500 words and be typed in double-space.
- A synopsis of your activities during your high school career that may include, but are not limited to academia, extracurricular activities, sports, civic involvement, family activities, work experience, religious affiliations, offices held, awards, and scholarships received. Proven intent on attending a four-year college or university or other post graduate educational institutions.
 - Submit proof of application or a copy of a letter of acceptance from the institution of higher learning of choice.

*Applications missing any of the above listed materials may not be considered by the Evaluation Board.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

The Sallter/Saulter Family Memorial Scholarship Committee will recommend the scholarship candidate(s) to the family members at the reunion business meeting for ultimate approval. The Committee's criteria for final selection will include the applicant's financial need, writing skills, character references, demonstration of leadership ability, and community/family involvement.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

The minimum scholarship amount is \$500.

SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

In order to comply with scholarship guidelines, recipient must submit proof of full-time enrollment at a college or university, or other post graduate educational institutions.

A check will be made payable to the family member.
